When renewing your drivers license pay a one time fee of \$1 and the word "Veteran" will be added. You will need a copy of your DD-214 showing honorable discharge. POST 148 SCOUTING PROGRAM

The past two months were exciting and busy for our Post 148 Scouting program! Here's some of the things YOUR program has accomplished: camping, hiking, fishing, learned survival skills, retired American Flags, supported the Oratorical Contest with color guard, participated in Scout Sunday, attended a STEM lock-in at MOSI, held a pinewood derby, and had our annual Blue & Gold Banquet. By February, the majority of our Scouts earned their next rank and was promoted. We also served the community by collecting over 500lbs of food with our annual Scouting for Food drive.

The post's program received national Boy Scouts of America (BSA) recognition by earning the Journey to Excellence (JTE) Gold Award for achieving the highest marks for the 2016 program year. JTE is the BSA equivalent to the Legion's Consolidated Post Report (CPR). Both are reported annually to Congress. Likewise, the Post 148 Charter Organization Representative (Post 148 BSA Chair) received a BSA national award, the James E. West Fellowship Award as well as receiving local BSA Timucua District recognition with a Key Leader award. A long-term adult volunteer member of Pack 606, Kristen Inzerillo, a pillar of the unit, received a BSA Shield of Service Award.

They said it couldn't be done, but we did it! We led the way in the Department by changing our BSA unit numerals from Pack "606" to Pack "1481" and Troop "1482". Because we charter the BSA units, it is like adoption. We "own and operate" the BSA unit, that includes financially and administratively. It only makes sense to change their last names to ours. From this point forward, our BSA units will have "148" after them the same as SAL 148, ALR 148, and ALA 148.

Not only is our Post 148's BSA program leading the way in District 15, it is being recognized at the Department and National level as well. Our Post's Scouting program was briefed to the National Vice Commander and a member of the National Membership Committee on March 4th. They wanted to know what our secret sauce was and how we were using Scouting to grow membership and improve the CPR. It is simple: go back to our roots and have fun. It was the American Legion that led the way in the Scouting movement for decades since the great wars. It was veterans that led our young me in service. That is the legacy we are continuing.

On May 17th at 6:30pm at the Collins Elementary School cafeteria in Panther Trace, we will conduct a first-of-its-kind ceremony for BSA and the American Legion. We will retire Cub Scout Pack 606 and stand-up new Legion units Pack 1481 and 1482. It is a Legion family event and all are encouraged to attend in their uniforms to support the families who are out in the community representing you.
