#### ARMED FORCES DAY

Armed Forces Day is a day to pay tribute to the men and women who serve the United States Armed Forces. Armed Forces Day, which is celebrated on the third Saturday in May, is part of Armed Forces Week.

- It was with the idea for citizens to come together and thank our military members for their patriotic service in support of our country that President Harry S. Truman led the effort to establish this single holiday. The one-day celebration then stemmed from the unification of the Armed Forces under the Department of Defense. It was on August 31, 1949, that Secretary of Defense Louis Johnson announced the creation of an Armed Forces Day to replace separate Army, Navy, Marine Corps, U.S. Coast Guard and Air Force Days.
- Parades, open houses, receptions and air shows were held to celebrate the first Armed Forces Day held on May 20, 1950. President John F. Kennedy established Armed Forces Day as an official holiday in 1962.

Much of the 20th century's definition of patriotism - love of country - was either conceived or greatly amplified by The American Legion. A committee to tackle this sprawling interest was formed in November 1919 at the 1st American Legion National Convention in Minneapolis to:

- 1: Combat all anti-American tendencies, activities and propaganda
- 2: Work for the education of immigrants, prospective American citizens and alien residents in the principles of Americanism
- 3: Inculcate the ideals of Americanism in the citizen population, particularly the basic American principles that the interest of all the people are above those of an any special interest or any so-called class or section of the people 4: Spread throughout the people of the
- nations information as to the real nature and principles of American government
- 5: Foster the teaching of Americanism in all schools.






**Beginning with the July 2019** American Legion membership renewal cycle, dues will be increased to \$45 annually (effective for the 2020 Legion Year).
